



## MOBEYE LEAK DETECTION

Mobeye CM2300 feels the water



The archive, wine or holiday stuff, most basements are full of valuables. A great storage location, as long as it stays dry. The Mobeye WaterGuard alerts when the leak sensor notices water. Only a small amount of water is enough to let the built-in GSM dialler inform you via SMS message and / or call, before the water causes a lot of damage.

### Mobeye CM2300

**CM2300** The Mobeye WaterGuard is a compact battery operated unit with integrated GSM dialler and an external leakage sensor. Batteries are included.

#### Optional:

**Adapter** The unit could be mains powered using the adapter.

**Extension cable** Weak GSM network strength in a cellar can be solved by placing the unit at another location and extending the wired sensor cable.

### How it works

- Insert a SIM card in the holder; this can be card of any network supplier.
- Insert the batteries (included in Packaging) in the Mobeye WaterGuard.
- Program at least one telephone number to which the unit send an SMS or calls after upon the detection of water.
- Fix the leak sensor with the pins downwards, at the height where water shall be detected, using screws through the holes. Insert the plug of the sensor into the main unit.
- Optionally a mains adapter can be applied. In this way you'll receive an alert upon power failure.
- If the network strength is weak in the cellar, the sensor cable can be extended. The main unit with the GSM dialler can be put at a place with good reception.
